Answering this call for help could not be more urgent. According to the Freestore Foodbank, one in seven of our neighbors in the Tri-State area is at risk of hunger.

### Dan Beard Council Scouting For Food: How Does it Work?

On **Veterans Day weekend, Scouts will place flyers as** we post flags for FlagoverWaynesville. We are asking for non-perishable food donations.

On the following weekend, when we retrieve the flags, scouts will return to the homes where flyers were placed to collect the donations, which then will be dropped off at :
